
Magic II

Magic II will be sailing in early summer 2024 from The Netherlands to France.

June 1-8, Vlissingen to Cherbourg


Leaving Vlissingen we follow the Belgian and French coasts staying well south of the large commercial vessel traffic lanes in the middle of the English Channel.

The planned stops are (mileage approximate):

Possible continuation of the trip, week 2-3: Week 2, June 9-15, Cherbourg to Lorient




The second week includes a stop at the Channel Island (UK) of Guernsey and the contour of the tip of Brittany.

Week 3, June 16-22, Lorient to La Rochelle



The third week is the shortest distance covered with stops at the well-known bases for famous ocean racing boats of Lorient and Les Sables-d'Olonne.

La Rochelle	71	total 179


The Boat

Magic II is a Hallberg Rassy 342, a Germán Frers design built in Sweden in 2009, hull 207 out of 300 built. The boat is very well equipped; it has a good sail inventory and recently installed new B&G equipment including chart plotter, displays, wind instruments and a powerful autopilot. The engine is a Volvo-Penta with 700 hours.

The interior of the HR342 is particularly comfortable with two ample cabins, a fully enclosed head with shower, a well equipped galley with refrigerator and a full forwardfacing navigation table. The boat has central heat throughout. The boat can sleep six with two on the salon settees which open up to wide berths by raising the backrests.

Magic II sails under French flag with home port of Boulogne-sur-Mer.
